## REQUIREMENTS Cost: \$25 (Cash Only)

### Bring one of the following:

- ✓ Passport; Driver license or ID Card from country of origin. (current or expired).
  - ✓ Consular ID.
  - ✓ DHS/ICE Miramar office Check-In
- Paperwork must have a photo and a seal. (Parole)

### Proof that you live in Broward: (one of the following)

- ✓ Utility bill, rental agreement, bank or phone statement, medical bill, or any document that has your address and name on it.
- ✓ It can also be a notarized letter from the person you live with or a letter from the social worker if you live in a shelter.



**What is a Broward Community ID Card?** The Broward Community ID Card is a Broward County authorized document that helps residents identify themselves to law enforcement, schools, banks, among other private and public entities. The Broward Community ID is not a federal or state ID or a driver license. It cannot be used to vote or to board an airplane.
