# FREE LEGAL HELP FOR SURVIVORS OF TRAFFICKING.

#### Spot the signs of trafficking:

- Minor is not attending school regularly
- Not in control of money, finances, or bank accounts
- No identification documents
- Dramatic change in behavior
- Showing signs of physical abuse
- Malnourished
- Does not like to make eye contact
- Responses seem scripted and disoriented as if they are being coached on what to say
- · Unsure of their whereabouts
- · Has few personal possessions
- Waits for a third party to answer auestions for them
- · Is being constantly monitored
- Unaware of surroundings/time/date
- Unable to come and go freely
