Nominations should be submitted via email to [mmalone@legalaid.org](mailto:mmalone@legalaid.org) prior to noon on Wednesday, March 31, 2021.

Individuals or organizations being nominated should meet the following criteria:

- Past winners cannot be nominated again.
- Nominees should be non-partisan and apolitical.

Selection will be based on the following:

- How has the individual or organization had an impact on an issue or cause in the community which bears a relationship to the work of LAS and/or CCLA?
- What is the impact of the individual or organization's dedication on those they serve?
- Does the individual or organization have a reputation for professionalism and integrity in the community?
